Over the Easter weekend we were able to secure a spectacular faculty guest artist, violinist Soyoung Yoon. Soyoung, one of the leading violinists of our generation, will be a faculty guest artist for both weeks of PRISMA.

Due to this last minute exciting addition, PRISMA has agreed to extend the application deadline to April 8. Students admitted to PRISMA will get the chance to work with Soyoung Yoon on a daily basis and perform the Tchaikovsky violin concerto with her as soloist.

A number of students requested additional time to complete their applications due to Easter falling on the original deadline. Students will now have until April 8 to complete the application and audition recording."

Soyoung won first prize at the 2002 Yehudi Menuhin International Violin Competition at the age of seventeen and is a prize winner of the top four violin competition in the world - the International Tchaikovsky Competition in 2007, the Queen Elisabeth Competition in 2009, the International Violin Competition of Indianapolis in 2010 and the Wieniawski Violin Competition in 2011.
